Eligibility

- Graduate of public or private high school in Highlands County, Florida
- Resident of Highlands County, FL for at least one year
- Minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA
- Expectation to attend Florida State University in fall, or letter of acceptance to FSU
- *Past recipients are eligible, but must reapply each year*

Selection Criteria (listed in order of priority)

1. Financial Need (based on your FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid which will be provided to the selection committee with your FSU admissions application)
2. Academic potential and past performance (minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA)
3. Community Involvement or service
4. Participation in extracurricular activities (sports, clubs, employment, etc.)
5. *Intention of enrolling or current enrollment at FSU*

Scholarships are awarded after applications are reviewed and prioritized by the Florida State University Admissions Scholarship Committee and are based on the guidelines set forth by the Highlands Seminole Club Board of Directors, and as described above.
