The Chattanooga Seminole Club is pleased to offer a scholarship to an incoming or current FSU student* who is a resident of the Chattanooga area**.

The one-time scholarship is based on funding available, a minimum of \$500. The application must be postmarked or emailed to the Board by May 15. You can send a scan of both pages to ChattaNoles@gmail.com or send a hard copy to Chattanooga, TN 37412. You will receive an email to the email address provided to confirm that we've received your application. If you do not receive that email by May 15, it is your responsibility to follow up with the Board at the email or mailing address above, or via phone at 423-315-0228. If awarded, the scholarship award will be deposited by the Chattanooga Seminole Club directly to the student's Financial Aid account to be administered for the upcoming Fall semester. Depending on the number of applicants, the Club reserves the right for follow up questions. No additional sheets or documentation are required at this time, but will be accepted (transcripts, resume, et cetera) or may be requested later.

All applicants will be invited to the Seminole Send Off Event, usually held in July, where we will announce the winner. Details on the Send Off will be sent via email, Facebook, and the Seminole Clubs website.
